The Gulf of Mexico Regional Collaboration Team supports the 7th annual Gulf of Mexico Climate Outreach Community of Practice (CoP) meeting in Biloxi, Mississippi on April 19-21, 2016. The CoP brings together education, outreach, and extension professionals with local community decision-makers and climate experts for an exchange of ideas and best practices. The CoP enables opportunities for increased public awareness and improved resilience to climate and storm-related impacts in coastal communities around the Gulf of Mexico region.
