Federal COVID-19 Guidelines

Masking:

- **HIGH** COVID-19 Community Level: Masks are required while in NOAA spaces.
- **MEDIUM** COVID-19 Community Level: Masks are generally not required but strongly encouraged while interacting closely with others.
- **LOW** COVID-19 Community Level: Masks are not required but individuals may continue to wear masks based on personal preferences or needs.

Testing: COVID-19 screening testing is not required.

Vaccination Certification: Contractors, affiliates and visitors are not required to provide attestation of their vaccination status.
